#### **The Last Supper**

#### **Luke 22:7-20**

Jesus and His disciples were reclining at their Passover meal. Jesus blessed the matzoh bread and broke it, saying to them, "Take this and eat it, for this is my body."

Then He blessed the wine and passed around his cup. "Drink this, for this is my blood."

Then Jesus looked at each of his disciples. His face was full of sorrow. "One of you sitting here will betray me." The disciples were horrified and looked at each other in dismay. "Is it me?" "Who is it?" they asked.

Jesus answered, "The one to whom I shall give this bread." Then Jesus took a piece of bread from the loaf, dipped it in the dish of wine and handed it to Judas Iscariot.
